

## Tests before plastic surgery under general anesthesia:

1. Clinical blood count (complete + platelets)
2. Determination of blood type and RH factor
3. Clinical analysis of urine with urine microscopy
4. Biochemical blood test:

- total protein
- creatinine
- urea
- bilirubin
- ALT
- AST
- sugar (glucose)

5. Coagulogram:

- prothrombin
- fibrinogen
- APTT
- thrombin time
- INR
- D-dimer

6. Examination for:

- Hepatitis B
- Hepatitis C
- HIV
- Syphilis

7. Ultrasound examination of lower extremity veins

8. Fluorography over the past 12 months

9. ECG with description and ECG tape

10. ECHO CG for patients over 50.

11. Consultation with a physician and a conclusion that there are no contraindications to the surgery.

Women in addition

12. Breast ultrasound + mammologist's conclusion (for breast surgery)

13. Pelvic ultrasound for patients over 40 years (with indication of presence or absence of free fluid and condition of pelvic veins)
